<p>Other costs of living</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Exchange students are exempt from tuition fees but they need to pay a semester contribution ranging around 250 € (the bus card is included) - Lunch at the Ostfalia: between 2 – 5€ - Coffee at the Ostfalia: 1€ - Sandwich at the Ostfalia: 1,50€ - Dinner in a restaurant: 10 -15€ - Health insurance: 82,50 € /month - Rent: 250 – 400 € /month - TV licence: 17,50 €/moth - Mobile phone: approx. 15 - 20 €/month - We guess that students need between 800 and 1000 € per month
<p>Application procedure</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Nomination by home institution - International exchange student submits: applicaton form, learning agreement, transcript of records, curriculum vitae, motivation letter, ID or passport copy, passport size picture, application hall of residence) - Student prepares the application documents and sends them to us
