# Arriving in Brazil

If you are coming by air, one of the options is to land at the Salgado Filho International Airport (POA), in Porto Alegre, and take a bus to Santa Maria. You can also take a direct flight to the Santa Maria Airport (RIA), but it is small and has limited flight options.

# Arriving in Santa Maria

In Santa Maria, there are two bus stations: one is located near downtown and the other is located in Camobi (where UFSM is located). If you are planning on getting off at the Camobi station, it is the first stop when you are coming from Porto Alegre and you should let the driver know that you plan to get off there.

Upon arrival in Santa Maria, you will need to obtain the following documents.

# Important Documents

Registro Nacional Migratório (RNM)
(National Migratory Registration): this
document is issued by the Federal Police.
The service must be scheduled in
advance (ask your international friend to
assist you). Click on "Registro de
imigrante detentor de visto temporário"
(Registration of immigrants with a
temporary visa).

Personal Tax ID Number (CPF): can be requested along with the visa at the Brazilian diplomatic representation in your country. It is also possible to request the CPF through the Brazilian Federal Revenue Office (Receita Federal) website, in this link.

# Arriving at UFSM

Make an effort to arrive in Santa Maria at least one week before your classes begin, so that you can obtain all the necessary documents in time.


Upon your arrival, you must report to the International Affairs Office (SAI) to deliver your documents and request enrollment.

SAI is in building 47 (Central Administrative Offices), on the 7th floor, room 739.

Office hours (from Monday to Friday):

Morning: 8:30 to 11:30 a.m.

Afternoon: 2:00 to 5:00 p.m.



### International Orientation Week

# Housing in Santa Maria

The university campus is located in Camobi, 10 km from downtown Santa Maria. You can find a place to live in Camobi or in any other neighborhood.


The main advantage of living in Camobi is the proximity to UFSM and the short commute time. In addition, the university campus is a great option for leisure activities and outdoor sports.

The advantage of living downtown is the greater variety of shopping and entertainment options. Travel time from downtown to Camobi is approximately 40 minutes, which can vary depending on traffic and means of transportation.

## Sockets and voltage



The current official standard for plugs and sockets is the three-prong outlet, but you can also find two-prong outlets in some places.



The voltage in the city of Santa Maria is 220 Volts, so make sure your devices are designed to use this voltage or are dual-voltage.

# City Transportation

University students have a 50% discount on bus fare (public transportation), which currently costs R\$2,50-- after the discount.

To obtain the discounted fare, you must register as a student at the ATU (Associação dos Transportadores Urbanos de Passageiros de Santa Maria, the Santa Maria Public Transportation Association). To do this, you will need to take your certificate of enrollment (comprovante de matrícula) and proof of address to the ATU as soon as you have completed enrollment at UFSM.

To check bus routes and schedules, you can download the Urmob app.





# University Restaurant

UFSM has a university restaurant (RU) that offers 3 meals a day (breakfast, lunch and dinner).


The price of meals for regularly enrolled students at UFSM is R\$2.50 (two reais and fifty cents). Students whose exchange program provides meal stipends (AUGM) do not pay for meals at RU.

To gain access to the restaurant, students must apply for an RU card at the UFSM Student Portal. Students must also schedule their meals in advance on the UFSM app or at the University Restaurant portal.

### UFSM App

This resource provides students and employees with access to a number of features, including the university restaurant menu, meal scheduling, library book renewals, student grades and absences for the current semester and bus schedules. The app also provides a digital version of the Student Card, (e-card), which can be used in place of its physical version.

When your exchange period is over, the International Affairs Office (SAI) will forward your academic transcript to your home university within 30 days.


