2. GENERAL INFORMATION

2.1 Candidates must submit their application in accordance with the available vacancies under each Theme and the specific requirements of each scholarship category;

2.2 Selected candidates must submit any additional documentation requested by the Theme Coordination and/or CAPES, and sign the Scholarship Commitment and Acceptance Term;

2.3 In cases where a scholarship is not implemented, alternate candidates will be called:

2.3.1 First, within the research theme in which the vacancy is available;

2.3.2 If the vacancy is not filled by alternates or if there are no qualified candidates within the research theme, it may be filled by an alternate from other research themes on the waitlist for the same scholarship category, in an order defined by the specific guidelines for that category;

2.4 Scholarship holders must submit a Technical Report covering the scholarship period, aligned with the goals and indicators defined in their research project and activity plan, to their Theme Coordinator within 30 (thirty) days after the scholarship ends. Specific reports or documents may be requested directly from the recipient by CAPES and remain the sole responsibility of the scholarship holder;

2.5 Unforeseen situations will be resolved by the Selection Committee, the Graduate Program Board responsible for the selection, or the CAPES-Global/UFSM Management Committee, depending on the instance involved.
