The Huge Challenge to Start the New Human-Animal Relationship

Strong resilience of animal production facing diverse critics ... in the past



- Hormones/70s, ESB/90s, melanin crisis/00, horse-beef meat/10s...
- Breeding conditions: poultry, pigs, dairy, feed-lots, slaughtering...
- Several land conflicts between small holders and large ranches
- *Livestock = tool of colonization over the past centuries^{2 10-16+4}*

... and genocide of native populations"

The Huge Challenge to Start the New Human-Animal Relationship

Significant environmental impacts of animal production

(18% Greenhouse Gas Emission)

- Especially ruminants due to methane production
- Extensive farming systems due to forage consumption
- Intensive farming systems due to dejections

⇒ Animal production is no more “nature”

Animal welfare, Veganism,=> livestock blacklisting?





- **Long-Term Analysis of Livestock Policies in Diverse Contexts**
 - **Hypothesis:** 1. Cycles, 2. Similarities & Contrasts, 3. Local vs Global
 - **Material:** 22 case studies = 22 livestock areas in 20 countries

LIFLOD / Livestock Policy Research Sites



Methods & Research strategy (LIFLOD network)

- **Long-Term Analysis of Livestock Policies in Diverse Contexts**
 - **Hypothesis:** 1. Cycles, 2. Similarities & Contrasts, 3. Local vs Global
 - **Material:** 22 case studies = 22 livestock areas in 20 countries
 - **Method:**
 - Product = paper (12-15p/25-30,000 characters) => comparative analysis
 - Written by local stakeholder(s), scientist or not
 - Long-term analysis: >50-80 years
 - 3-4 main steps and their factors of change
 - Regarding changes in socio-demographic, technology and policy
- **Different/Contrasted Livestock Mental Models**
 - **Hypothesis:** different points of view, perceptions, representations...
 - **Material & Methods:** joining skill/experiences to identify mental models
 - **Product:** description of each mental model by one (or 2) representative

“Specific” Results (1)

- **Five main cycles in livestock policy (... globalization)**
 - 2nd WW until 50s: policy at local scale by 1-3 industries (milk, meat, ...)
 - End of 50s and 60s: Tests of different models (export, import, ...)
 - 70s-80s: market controlled by animal diseases and food safety barriers
 - 90s: Scandals of ESB, Vaca louca, Vache folle...
 - 90-00s: environmental issues => any policy cares environmental issue
 - 10s: Organic production, smart agriculture, veganism ...

=> Globalization

- **Start at the end of the 19th Century:** GB/Fray Bentos Slaughterhouse
- **Trend to similar livestock policy:** environmental issue! Welfare/vegan?
- **Global > Local governance:** norms, even traditional rules survive...



 => Higher risk of conflicts




The Huge Challenge to Start the New Human-Animal Relationship
